Objectives: Transnational Creation and Circulation

- Strengthen the transnational creation and circulation of European works and artists.

Priorities

- Audience: Increase access, engagement, and participation in culture, particularly content from countries other than their own.
- International Dimension: Build the capacity of cultural and creative sectors for active cross-border collaboration, contributing to international cultural relations and the Union's global strategy.

Expected Impact

The action European Cooperation Projects aims to foster transnational cooperation, exchanges, and the development of new and innovative practices within the cultural field. The project seeks to increase the European dimension of artistic content creation and circulation.

Project Phases

1. Research:
 - Selection of literature, stories, and oral traditions.
 - Exploration of notable examples like the Trees ritual of Basilicata and Icelandic Volcanoes.
2. Training/Exchange Practice + Workshops:
 - Collaborative sharing of research findings.
 - Mutual exchange of competencies and know-how among participants.
3. Co-Creation + Artistic Residency + Workshops:
 - Development of immersive audio-guides.
 - Testing and refinement in each country.



4. Post-Production of Audios:

- Production of final audio guides.

5. Festival and Presentations:

- Showcasing the project through live performances.
- Transformation of literature into various artistic forms.

6. Outputs:

- Flyers, video, dossiers of the performance.

7. Online Dissemination (App?):

- Widespread dissemination through online platforms.

Link is looking for two additional partners interested in working on the definition of the project proposal and, if approved, in implementing the project.

The organizations should have the following characteristics:

- at least 3 years' experience in the sector of international mobility and cultural production;
- be active in one of the eligible countries;
- have the ability to work in international contexts and participate in all phases of the project;
- formulate a proposal consistent with the theme of the project (for example exploring other natural elements such as the sea, the wind...) starting from one's own literary and ethno-anthropological heritage.
