What are we talking about ???

- ➔ As France will be welcoming the **Euro 2016**, we propose an EVS combining volunteering missions around sport activities, developed at Eurocircle and in our partner organisations, and missions for the UEFA EURO 2016 Volunteers Programme.
- ➔ The EVS will last 9 months and will be located in Marseille (South of France).



But what are the activities proposed?

- Missions developed at Eurocircle :
 - organisation of workshops, creation of tools...to promote sport and its values and to fight against racism and discrimination in those fields
 - update the blog of volunteers (Pass'sport blog)
 - preparation and organization of a sport event in the frame of the Day of Europe, on the 9th of may 2016 (see <http://www.fetedeleurope.eu/> to have an overview on last year event)
 - preparation and organisation of the « European week of sport » in Marseille in September 2016
- Missions developed in our partner organisations (Point Sud, Addap13, CREPS,...) :
 - organising sport activities for children, youngsters or disabled people (Football, rugby, nautical activities,...) ; promotion of anti-doping measures

And what about the EURO 2016 ?

During their EVS, the volunteers will have the opportunity to participate in the organization of the *Euro 2016*, the UEFA football tournament. Scheduled in France, **from the 10th of June to the 10th of July 2016**, several matches will be organized in Marseille.

Many different missions are proposed to the volunteers, according to the profile and interests of the youngsters (match organization, fan zones, ICT, hospitality, logistics operations, sustainable development, ...).

What about the practical arrangements ?

Volunteers are hosted in a full equipped flat, shared with other volunteers and/or students, located in the city centre of Marseille. Every volunteer gets 295€ as monthly allowance: 180€ for the food and 115€ for the pocket money.

What is the required profile ?



Being a sport practiser is absolutely not mandatory to take part to this EVS : the most important criteria is **the motivation for the mission !**

Also a motivation for engagement, for volunteering and for the values promoted with sport is requested.

Note that the UEFA EURO 2016 Volunteers Programme **requires** the candidates to have some French notions.

So, sportiv or not, boy or girl, if you feel like you want to be part of this project, do not hesitate to candidate !!!
