What is the CES ?

ESC (European Solidarity Corps [Volunteering projects], former European Voluntary Service [EVS]) is an international volunteer experience funded by the European Commission. It allows young people (17 to 30 years old) resident in Europe to have a full-time international and intercultural volunteer experience in an organisation abroad for a period of time between 2 and 12 months. It provides the travel expenses, full board (food and accommodation) and an amount of pocket money per month (it varies depending on the country).

The hosting organization

The AAAMI (Association pour l'Accompagnement des Actions de Mobilité Internationale), created in 2012, has as main objective to promote and build mobility programmes in Europe and abroad for young people and professionals.

The AAAMI association works in the framework of short/long term European volunteering and youth exchanges, in particular for young people with fewer opportunities from the cities of Grenoble Echirolles, Pont de Claix, Eybens, Saint Martin d'Hères...

We are both a support association and a host association in the framework of the "European Solidarity Corps" programme since 2017.

Activities

The main activities of the AAAMI are:

- information on European issues,*
- sensibilization about citizenship and European mobility programs,*
- foster the socio-professional integration of 17-30 years,*
- fight against dropping out of school and discrimination.*

The volunteer will have the possibility to participate and purpose events to share her/his experience, give some English classes, help the youngsters to find the best project abroad and prepare the application, network with our local and UE partners, develop her/his personal project...

04 Locations

The city of Grenoble is surrounded by mountains. The volunteer will have the possibility to discover 3 mountain ranges: le Vercors, la Chartreuse and Belledune.

Indeed, there are lots of opportunities for leisure activities: hiking, climbing, skiing...

Support for the volunteer

- *About the transport to Grenoble, the volunteer will be reimbursed for their tickets, according to the Distance Calculator of the E.U. (275€ by plane or 320€ by train or bus).*
- *About local transport, the volunteer will have the choice between a bike or a transport card.*
- *About the food, the volunteer will receive 210€ per month (7€ per day). She/He can receive this allowance weekly or monthly.*
- *About pocket money, the volunteer will receive 180€ per month (6€ per day). She/He can receive this allowance weekly or monthly.*
- *The volunteer will have the possibility to make a monthly or weekly update with her/his tutor to speak about her/his activities, needs, personal project...*
- *The volunteer will have a mentor who will help with her/his daily life.*

Support for the volunteer

- *The volunteer will participate in a pre-departure training then will be invited in an arrival and mid-term training organized by the French National Agency.*
- *She/He will have access to an online platform to learn French and will have weekly classes organized by the AAAMI.*
- *The volunteer will have the possibility to make a monthly or weekly update with her/his tutor to speak about her/his activities, needs, personal project...*
- *The volunteer will have a mentor who will help with her/his daily life: meeting people, transports, activities, weekends...*
- *The volunteer will always have 2 consecutive days off and you earn 2 vacation days per month.*
