What is the CES ?

ESC (European Solidarity Corps [Volunteering projects], former European Voluntary Service [EVS]) is an international volunteer experience funded by the European Commission. It allows young people (17 to 30 years old) resident in Europe to have a full-time international and intercultural volunteer experience in an organisation abroad for a period of time between 2 and 12 months. It provides the travel expenses, full board (food and accommodation) and an amount of pocket money per month (it varies depending on the country).

The lead organization

The AAAMI (Association for the Support of International Mobility Actions), created in 2012, has as main objective to promote and build mobility programs in Europe and internationally for young people and professionals, whether individual or collective.

AAAMI will deal with the logistical aspect, the french classes, the trainings...

The hosting organization

The BIJ: Youth Initiative and Information Office is a structure used by the YouthPath (YP) for the territorial collectivity of the City of Échirolles.

Created in 2017, this service wants to create local initiatives in a non-formal educational way allowing the youngsters to grow up. .

The YP wanted to increase its expertise about international mobility which is a vector for emancipation.

One of the main axes of work is the development of «brainstorming». Those events happen one's a month, in order to help the youngsters between 16 and 30 participating on reflexions about actual problems of the society, and also on local dynamics that were emerging. It develops citizenship commitment and sometime involve youngsters in local projects.

Activities

The volunteer will:

- be linked with the youngsters in order to help them with their resumes;*
- participate in keeping a good mood inside the YIIO;*
- discuss with the youngsters about their questions and their wishes;*
- accompany innovative projects with general interest with local youngsters;*
- participate in a collective project with some other volunteers about international mobility with the AAAMI;*
- suggest some ideas and initiatives in their centres of interest.*

05 Locations

The city of Grenoble is surrounded by mountains. The volunteer will have the possibility to discover 3 mountain ranges: le Vercors, la Chartreuse and Belledune.

Indeed, there are lots of opportunities for leisure activities: hiking, climbing, skiing...

The volunteer will discover the typical gastronomy: Gratin dauphinois, les ravioles la raclette, la fondue...

Support for the volunteer

- *About the transport to Grenoble, the volunteer will be reimbursed for their tickets, according to the Distance Calculator of the E.U. (275€ by plane or 320€ by train or bus).*
- *About local transport, the volunteer will have the choice between a bike or a transport card.*
- *About the food, the volunteer will receive 210€ per month (7€ per day). She/He can receive this allowance weekly or monthly.*
- *About pocket money, the volunteer will receive 180€ per month (6€ per day). She/He can receive this allowance weekly or monthly.*
- *The volunteer will have the possibility to make a monthly or weekly update with her/his tutor to speak about her/his activities, needs, personal project...*
- *The volunteer will have a mentor who will help with her/his daily life.*

Support for the volunteer

- *The volunteer will participate in a pre-departure training then will be invited in an arrival and mid-term training organized by the French National Agency.*
- *She/He will have access to an online platform to learn French and will have weekly classes organized by the AAAMI.*
- *The volunteer will have the possibility to make a monthly or weekly update with her/his tutor to speak about her/his activities, needs, personal project...*
- *The volunteer will have a mentor who will help with her/his daily life: meeting people, transports, activities, weekends...*
- *The volunteer will always have 2 consecutive days off and you earn 2 vacation days per month.*
