The project

The main focus of the project is to visit TANODA, a special kind of afternoon school for mainly teenagers who are disadvantaged in different ways, or have learning difficulties. Volunteers will introduce them their culture, play development games, organise language clubs... in general: improve teenagers social skills and knowledge about the world.

The two volunteers will work together and will have common accommodation. They will be part of the Foundation's team, they do all the background works and preparations in the office and go out to visit tanodas.

Szeged



Located 160 km from Budapest, Szeged is a regional centre in the South Plain Region of Hungary, and the third biggest town of the country with approximately 160,000 inhabitants. It is often referred to as The City of Sunshine, as on average, it receives the biggest number of sunlit hours a year in Hungary (but don't be surprised from the snow in winter...).



Szeged offers a lot of places like museums, cinemas and pubs, and the vibrant atmosphere attracts more and more tourists every summer.



The University of Szeged is among the best in the country, and with its 30,000 students, it contributes significantly to Szeged's lovely, intercultural and youthful picture.

Talentum Foundation is a regional volunteer centre coordinating local and international volunteers, organising professional trainings in various fields, manage museum, hospital and theatre volunteering, develop other civil organisations.
