ACCOMODATION, FOOD ALLOWANCE AND POCKET MONEY



- Volunteers will share an appartment with two other volunteers and will have a private bedroom.
- We will provide a weekly allowance (35€) for food for each volunteer.
- Volunteers will receive 5 € per day as Pocket Money.
- If needed, local transport will be covered.

PROJECT 1: Intercultural Youth

Hosting Organization:

AURYN ASSOCIATION

The main aim of this project is to promote the participation of the youth in different volunteer activities in Auryn Association, stimulating the intercultural education, the non-formal education, encouraging at the same time solidarity and tolerance among young people, basically to reinforce the social cohesion within the European Union.

The project will take place in Auryn Association with the aim of promoting children and youth integration throughout a leisure time and educational program focused on values linked with Human Rights, tolerance, respect and solidarity.



- Planning, development, and evaluation of the activities: prepare materials for school support, search for educational tools, workshops, sports activities, and/or artistic activities.
- Support the proper functioning and activities of the groups that are part of the Association.
- Participate in the development and management of youth projects and experiences with other countries of the European Union.

PROJECT 2: Connecting ages, connecting knowledge

Hosting Organization:

ALZHEIMER LEÓN

1 vacancy

Alzheimer Leon has been working for 25 years improving the quality of life of the Alzheimer patients and their families, and also making society awareness of that disease.

The purposes of the association are to improve the quality of life of the patients, to promote the investigation, to protect the affected people rights, to support the families and to inform society for developing the early diagnosis of new cases.

A multidisciplinary work team, with more than 60 professionals, social workers, psychologists etc. is in charge of developing the different programs, centres and services for the patients.



- Participating on daily activities with patients, with an initial training about the accompanying Alzheimer participants.
- Taking part on the diseminating and promoting activities.
- Taking part on the intergenerational activities of the organization, such as theatre, going out activities, etc.
- Participating in other activities such as environmental workshops, choir, yoga.
- Develop dissemination activities about Erasmus Plus and the European Solidarity Corps with youth at least once a month.

On the other hand, from the Alzheimer Centre we offer all the training that the volunteer will need and a close accompaniment of her/his growth.

PROJECT 3: Home

The main aim of this project is to promote the participation of the youth in different volunteer activities in Valponasca, stimulating the intercultural education from the non-formal education and the informal learning, encouraging at the same time solidarity and tolerance among young people, basically to reinforce the social cohesion within the European Union.

This volunteering project will take place in Valponasca, with the aim of promoting children and youth integration throughout a leisure time and educational program focused on values linked with Human Rights, tolerance, respect and solidarity.



- Support in carrying out daily school support tasks.
- Work on study techniques.
- Developing materials to reinforce the contents they are working on in class,
 as well as those in which they have more difficulty.
- Participate in workshops: Reading encouragement, Computer Science,
 Social skills, Artistic expression, etc.
- Search for and prepare materials to carry out the workshops.
- Support the educator in the workshops, carrying out the activity together with him/her.
- Evaluate the activity.
- To make a final report of the activities that have been carried out.
- Participate and design activities to do in leisure time.
- Produces a final report of the activities that have been carried out.
- Attending team meetings and reparation of weekly follow-ups.
- Support in secretarial tasks.
- Support in the management of social networks.

PROJECT 3: Empowering the Community

Don Bosco Youth Center is an entity which carries out an extensive project of community development and socio-educational intervention in the area of Armunia (in the periphery of León city) since 1980. This is an area with a high rate of population at social risk. In this context, the Youth Center has received an important and positive response by the neighborhood.

The aims of the association are linked with the promotion of the children and youth empowerment throughout a leisure education program which fosters values such as tolerance, respect, solidarity and interculturality.



- To provide educational support tasks with minors and to support the different projects of the center.
